

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT TECHCONNECT

## For Students

### How do I prepare for TechConnect?

Make note of the companies attending (we pre-advertise) and research the companies you are most interested in. If you will be bringing a resume, bring several copies. Also talk with professors, peers and others about their knowledge of the companies. Be yourself and be ready to talk!

### Who may attend TechConnect?

TechConnect is open to Engineering and Computer Science students currently enrolled in a BS, MEMP, Meng, MS, or PhD program at Duke University. Companies from all industry sectors are represented at the event!

### Should I bring a resume?

Yes, while TechConnect is more of a networking event, students are welcome to bring resumes.

### What should I expect during the networking portion of the event?

Employer representatives will be available at designated areas to chat with you about your background, interest in their company and review opportunities available.

### What do I need to bring to TechConnect?

Your questions and a resume! Please remember to research the companies prior to attending so that you are able to maximize your time asking relevant questions instead of asking what they do...

### What is the dress code?

Students will tend to dress more formally, but business casual is fine. For men, slacks and a long sleeve shirt, for women a skirt or slacks and blouse or shirt. No micro-minis, please!

### Is food service provided?

Yes! We provide light dinner of sandwiches, salad, fruit and dessert, sodas and water.

## For Industry Representatives

### Can we bring corporate giveaway items or literature about the company or jobs?

We ask that you only bring business cards or business card size info cards. iPads or other devices used expressly for the purpose of capturing student resumes are allowed.

Please **no** literature, laptops, demos, booths, or tablecloths. TechConnect is more focused on the networking and information exchange aspect of connecting employers with students than swag. This also reduces the environmental impact of recruiting as well as your need to haul in extra items, not to mention the \$ it will save in product and shipping!

### What is the dress code?

Business casual is the typical attire for employers. Most company representatives wear their company polo and slacks. Students will tend to dress more formally as they view this as an opportunity to make an important connection with industry representatives, but some will choose business casual.

### Will students bring resumes?

Yes, while TechConnect is more of a networking event, students do bring resumes, which you are welcome to accept!
